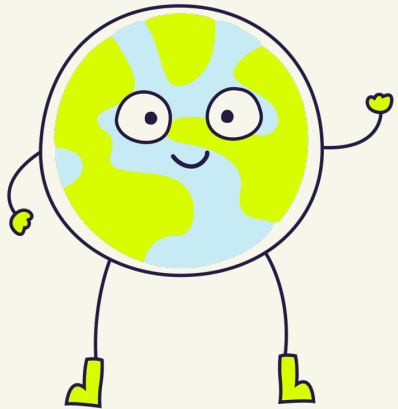


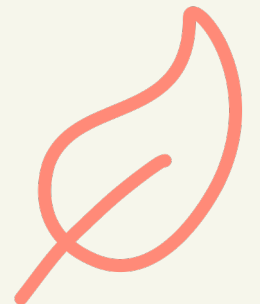
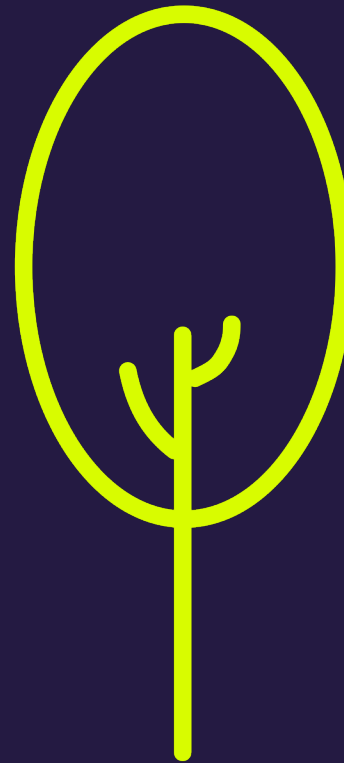

Can you grow a wildflower meadow in a pot at home?



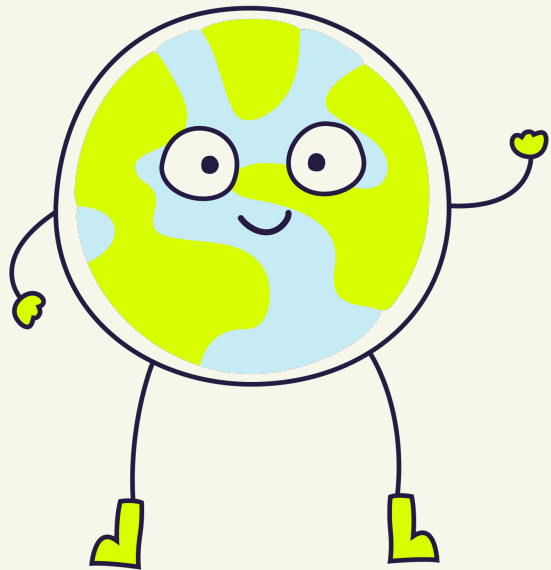

- A survey of urban plants revealed the pavements of Sheffield are home to 183 different plants, and the walls in Cambridge enable 186 species to flourish!!
- We have 1,100 varieties of wildflower in the UK. Wildflowers have evolved alongside our native wildlife and are particularly attractive to our native pollinators.
- Since the 1930s, our move towards larger-scale intensive farming and increased urbanisation, means we have lost 97% of UK wildflower meadows!

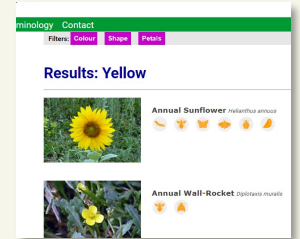

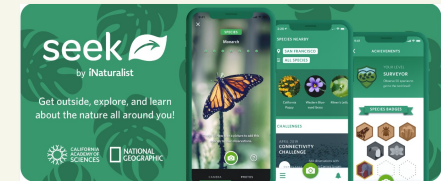
